Exam Procedures:

- All students are provided with up to double the official time noted above if they require it.

Students who arrive more than one hour late for a diploma exam will not be allowed to write it at this sitting and will need to rebook the exam on their own for the next diploma sitting in April.
- Graphing and scientific calculators may be used during the exams. All information will be cleared prior to writing the exam and again after the exam before the student leaves the exam room.
- Students who require audio must bring their own headphones (the kind that plugs in, not wireless).
- Phones, wearable technology, personal electronics, etc. are not allowed in the exam room.
- Students will not be allowed to wear hoodies or jackets.
- Students will need a clear bag for their pencil case. Purses, backpacks, opaque pencil cases, etc. are not allowed in the exam room.
- Extra paper will be provided to you and must be returned with your exam. No personal papers will be allowed in the exam room.
- Students are encouraged to bring a water bottle and quiet snacks.
- Students will need an HB pencil for the answer sheets
