Quality of Education:

SGEC	98.1	+9.1%	Alberta	89.0
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St. Gabe's quality of education standard continues to improve. We are +5.8% higher than our 3-year average and +7.8% higher than the provincial 3-year average.

Program of Studies:

SGEC	83.6%	+0.7%	Alberta	82.9%
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St. Gabe's improvement over our 3 year average is +27.5%, a significant improvement and testament to the work our teachers are doing to help students succeed.

High School Completion:

St. Gabe's high school completion rate is trending positively over our 3 year average. +20.9% over last year and +11.9% over our 3 year average.

Our parish priests preside over our liturgies when possible. Our junior high students join us online and usually they provide the readers for the prayers of the faithful.

Permeation:

Our division chaplain utilizes his Chaplain in Residence program to introduce students to reflective activities designed to create deeper meaning and connection to the community and their faith. We also invite our parish priests to our events so that we can foster a connection between the students and the parish. Students are given the opportunity to reflect on their faith through their religion classes as well as through the conversations and relationships that they build with staff.

Service:

At St. Gabe's we continue to celebrate our faith through liturgies, prayers and connections with our parish and division chaplain. We ARISE to serve our community through social justice projects such as collecting food for Lac St. Anne Parish, our Christmas toy drive, support for Catholic Social Services ministries and our staff faith retreat.

Student Safety:

Students at St. Gabe's report that they feel safe, welcome and cared for by the staff. Our results show:

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100% of our students report that they feel safe at school.

Our mandate at St. Gabriel Education Centre is to serve the junior and senior high school students of the greater St. Albert area, as well as province-wide, with their educational needs. We also serve a diverse population of mature students, adults, distance, and online learners. With the support of our teachers, counsellor, and administration, we work daily to provide a safe place for students to learn.

Inclusive Learning:

100% of our students report feeling welcome at school. At St. Gabe's, we focus on inclusion, respect, support, and the premise that all people can learn, regardless of their situation in life. We celebrate differences and diversity and support students to achieve their goals.

Foundational Knowledge of First Nations, Métis and Inuit:

Our 3 year average shows that students who identify as First Nations, Metis or Inuit are scoring at the acceptable standard on diplomas +14.5% higher than the provincial 3 year average.

Citizenship:

SGEC	94.3%	+12.9%	Alberta	81.4%
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100% of SGEC students report that they are encouraged to do their best. 94.3% of students are satisfied that they are being prepared for active citizenship in our world.

Student Engagement:

SGEC	92.9%	+7.8%	Alberta	85.1%
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92.9% of students at St. Gabe's report that they are engaged in their learning at school. Students understand what they're learning and that their classes are interesting to them. They enjoy access to 1-1 and small group learning. Their feelings of safety contribute to their learning.

Parent Involvement:

SGEC	100%	+21.2%	Alberta	78.8%
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Over the past 2 years, St. Gabes has consistently established a School Council. As part of the School Council, parents used their grant to organize a parent workshop on parenting older teens/young adults. Newsletter readership is continuing to increase, as reported by data gathered from the newsletter platform, S'more. In conversation, parents report that they feel included and welcome at their child's school.

School Improvement:

100% of our students report that they are proud of their school.
