<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Students report a +8.5% that teachers share their faith and the role of God in their lives.</li><li>Overall, students report a +2.0% increase over last year in that they find their school work interesting.</li><li>98% of students report that their overall education at SGEC is very good.</li><li>95.9% of students report that they can get help deciding what courses to take.</li><li>89.9% of students, a +7.2% increase over last year, report that they can get help planning for a career.</li><li>93.8% of students report that they are treated with care and respect by their peers at school.</li><li>97.9% of students report that they would recommend SGEC to a friend, and 91% report that they are confident that St. Gabes is a good school.</li><li>100% of parents report that the specialized support their child is receiving helps them to be successful learners.</li><li>100% of students report that SGEC has clear behavioural expectations, and students follow the rules.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Parents report that their children are encouraged to be involved in helping the community, but they would like to see more of these types of opportunities.</li><li>Students report that they are involved in works of charity and service to those in need, but there is an indication that they would like more service opportunities.</li><li>PAT and Dip results are variable at SGEC based on class and complexity.</li><li>Teachers will continue to share their faith with students.</li><li>Continue to promote our connections to post-secondary educational opportunities for students and connections to careers after they graduate.</li></ul>
